- 1. Welcome, Land Acknowledgement, Opening Prayer- N. Tome
- 2. Agenda- Budget for school yard discussion N. Tome
  - Reviewed the purpose of today's meeting
  - Mr. Tome reached out to Elaine, Mary and Angela
  - Wants to refresh pavement in the back and Full-day Kindergarten (FDK) yard
    - For FDK area: split the yard into two, expanding footprint outwards- two separate spaces so both classes can be out at the same time- this is funded by capital expenditures, which leaves the school yard with a black top and nothing on there

- For pavement: refresh with line painting and activity (see below for details)
- Mr. Tome obtained a quote from board-approved companies for:
  - Triple hoop x2- a post with a massive bucket and three wholes at the bottom- for primary ages who want to engage in basketball- cost: \$2,599 per post with installation
  - Line painting- hopscotch, handle ball, four square, basketball, etc.-\$4,700
- Board and ministry won't cover these expenses (triple hoop and line painting) due to the budget already absorbed
  - A lot of funds from the school budget go to student learning so don't want to use a significant chunk of the funding to for these activities, therefore seeking councils assistance
